EISPN Content Checklist:

- 1. Agency submittal letter and anticipated determination
- 2. Identification of applicant or proposing agency
- 3. Identification of accepting authority
- 4. Identification of consulted agencies, citizen groups, and individuals consulted in making the assessment
 - Was applicable county planning office notified of project?
 - Is the project in the conservation district, special management area, shoreline setback?
 - List of all required permits and approvals (State, Federal, County)
- 5. General description of the action's technical, economic, social, and environmental characteristics; time frame; funding source
- 6. Summary description of the affected environment, including suitable and adequate regional, location and site maps such as Flood Insurance Rate Maps, Floodway Boundary Maps, or United States Geological Survey topographic maps
 - Is the project located in an environmentally sensitive zone?
- 7. Identification and summary of impacts and proposed mitigation measures
 - Short Term (construction impacts)
 - Long Term: effects on water, air, archaeologic and historic district/sites, flora and fauna resources; noise, traffic, and visual impacts
- 8. Impacts to cultural practices and resources, past and current (Act 50, 2000)
- 9. Alternatives considered
- 10. Discussion of findings and reasons supporting the agency determination
- 11. Written comments and responses under the early consultation provisions of Sec. 11-200-9(a)(1), 11-200-9(b)(1), or 11-200-15, HAR
- 12. Agencies and community groups to be consulted during the EIS process
