DLNR Exemption list review:

Exemption Class 4

#8: Clarify to include arthropods in addition to vegetation.

-or-

#16: Clarify to ensure that pests apply to natural environments as well as built settings.

Exemption Class 5

#7: Suggest increasing the average surface disturbed area to greater than 1 square foot. Preferably clarifying that the boring diameter disturbance of any single boring not be greater than 12 inches. Justification: Make more consistent with #8 which limits test well casings to a 12 inch diameter, rather than setting a sq. foot disturbance limit which may or may not be related to the size of the drill hole disturbance. Other exemption classes clearly are not constrained by a 1 sq foot disturbance limit (especially class 3) and geotechnical surveys may entail both limited ground disturbance as well as the coring/boring location.

Exemption Class 8

#2: require consultation with the State Historic Preservation Division for any structure over 50 years old (*potentially* eligible for the National Register or Hawaii Register).

Justification: The Register is not always current and potentially eligible buildings should receive at least minimal evaluation by SHPD to ensure compliance with the National Historic Preservation Act.
